OBJECTIONS OF CHARLES BRADY, ET AL, TO THE PETITION FOR DISTRIBUTION OF THE ESTATE OF WILLIAM BRADY, DECEASED.

Come now your petitioners, Charles Brady, John Dunne, Anne Dunne and Mathew Dunne, residents of Leitrim, County Cavan, of Ireland; Patrick Dolan, a resident of Ballorkey, County Meath, Ireland; Mary Coffey, resident of Navan, County Meath, Ireland; Lizzie Daly, a resident of Carnaross, County Meath, Ireland; Lizzie Dunne and Bridget Dunne, residents of New York, N. Y., and file their objections to the Petition for Distribution in the above entitled Estate heretofore filed in this Court, by the State of California, and as grounds for such objections deny and allege:

I

Deny that said William Brady, deceased, died in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, leaving no heirs at law, and that since his death, no heirs of the said William Brady, have been in existence; deny that there are no heirs or persons whatever entitled to receive said estate or any portion thereof, and that all the property of said estate should escheat and has escheated to the State of California;

II.

Allege that said William Brady, died intestate on or about the 28th day of October, A. D., 1909, in the County of Los Angeles, State of California; that said deceased, at the time of his death, was a resident of said County and State, and left an estate in said County and State, consisting of personal property valued at \$71,490.34; that at the time of his death, said deceased was a widower; that in the year of 1883, said deceased had intermarried with one, Harriet Hayes, who remained his wife until the year 1894, at which time she died; that both said deceased and his said wife, died leaving no issue then surviving.

III.

Allege that your petitioner, Charles Brady, is the uncle of the half-blood of said William Brady, deceased, and your petitioners, Patrick Dolan, Mary Coffey, Lizzie Daly, Lizzie Dunne, John Dunne, Anne Dunne, Bridget Dunne and Mathew Dunne, are cousins of the half-blood of said William Brady, deceased, and your said petitioners are the sole surviving heirs at law of said William Brady, deceased.

IV.

Allege that at the time of the death of said William Brady, deceased, his estate consisted exclusively of his own property, none of which had been community property during the life time of said deceased and Harriet Hayes Brady, his said predeceased spouse.
