2 died about eighteen years ago leaving issue.

3 There were no other children born of either the first or
4 second marriage of my father.

5 We learned through Margaret Dely who married a man named
6 Callaghan and went to New York, returned to Ireland and died
7 some years ago, that my half-brother, William Brady, had married
8 Ann Kendall, that they had one son named William born about a
9 year after the marriage, that it was later reported they had
10 another son whose name she did not learn, that the parents died
11 while the two boys were quite young, and the last heard of
12 William was that he had gone to the State of Illinois. I have
13 since learned that that this William, the son of my half-brother
14 William, died in Los Angeles, California. I have caused search
15 to be made for any brother of my said nephew William Brady, but
16 found no trace whatever of him, and if he ever existed I verily
17 believe that he died many years ago leaving no issue.

18 My sister Annie left three children; namely, Patrick, Mary
19 and Elizabeth.

20 My sister Catherine left five children; namely, Elizabeth,
21 John, Ann, Bridget and Matthew. These eight are yet living.

22 I am an uncle of the half-blood of William Brady who died
23 in Los Angeles, California, and his sole next of kin and heir
24 at law.
